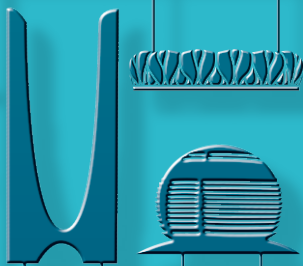

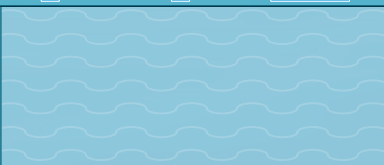

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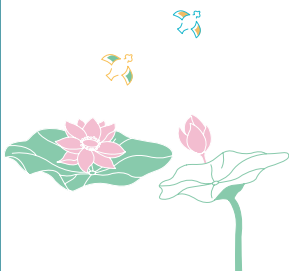
Hangzhou-styled life

Seasonal travel tips



Spring (March–mid-May)



Climate

☉ The weather gradually gets warmer, with the average temperature between 15°C and 20°C, and early summer often arrives in May.

Travel advice

☉ A popular choice is to view the flowers, such as the plum in Xixi Wetland Park, tulips in Prince Bay Park, and canola in Eight Diagrams Field. You can hike in the green hills or boat on the West Lake. A visit to Longjing tea garden is also a great option.

Seasonal food

☉ Spring bamboo shoot is the top choice for your palate. You can taste it in traditional dishes such as Pian'erchuan noodle, braised bamboo shoots, and Yanduxian pickled pork stew. A cup of freshly picked West Lake Longjing tea will leave your gastronomic trip no regret.

Summer (Mid-May–September)



Climate

☉ The average temperature stays steadily above 30°C, sometimes, even hitting 40°C.

Travel advice

☉ You can travel to West Lake to see the vast expanse of blooming lotus, to Qiandao Lake, Tonglu and other places to indulge yourself in the cool water world, or to Grand Canal or Qiantang River to enjoy the night cruise. You can also pay a visit to the bustling night markets.

Seasonal food

☉ A bowl of sour plum soup or lotus root powder soup helps beat the summer heat. Equally appealing are the crawfish and barbecues from night food stalls.





Autumn (October–Early December)

Climate

While the autumn air is cool and crispy, the temperature is gradually dropping and the night could be chilly. Since the weather cools significantly in November, it is necessary to have warm clothes ready.

Travel advice

Autumn in Hangzhou is short but gorgeous. The blooming sweet osmanthus flowers at Manjuelong, the changing yellow oriental plane leaves along Beishan Street, the red maple forests at Jiuxi Creek, and the ripening rice fields in Liangzhu combine to paint a colorful scroll.

Seasonal food

Food and drink containing sweet osmanthus flowers are the choice of the days. You can taste them in snacks like glutinous rice lotus roots, glutinous rice cakes. It's also a time to try freshly roasted sugared chestnuts and newly-harvested persimmons.

Winter (Early December–February)

Climate

The average temperature hovers between 4°C~12°C, the lowest temperature can be below zero. The air is humid and if you're lucky you may see snowfall.

Travel advice

If you like outdoor activities, you can travel to nearby Lin'an or Tonglu to try snow skiing. If you want to stay away from the cold air, find a warm teahouse for a leisurely afternoon. And there are always a host of traditional activities during the Spring Festival for you to enjoy.

Seasonal food

Steaming lamb pot and Lin'an warm pot are two major choices to help you ward off the bitter chill.

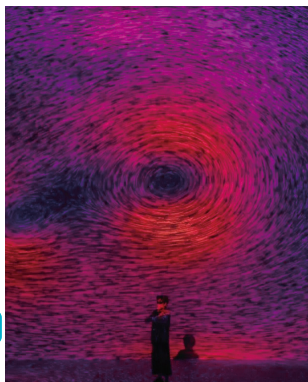

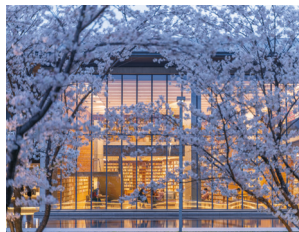




Liangzhu Culture and Art Center

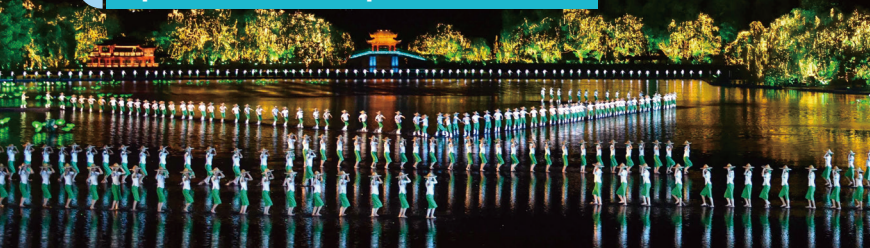

West Lake/Xihu



☉ The West Lake, known as "the most representative poetic dwelling spiritual home in China, and a paradise on earth full of Oriental quality and aesthetic charm", owes much of its fame to its picturesque "Ten Views" as well as abundant historical and cultural sites and anecdotes of celebrities. Let us follow the those highlights of the lake to appreciate its fantastic scenery and cultural richness.

Travel tips

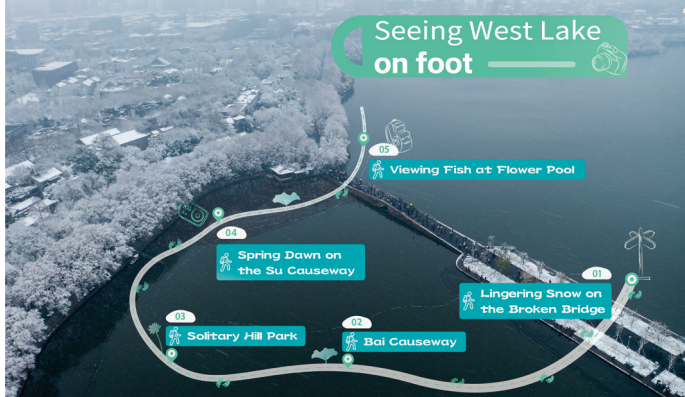
The "Ten Views of the West Lake" first appeared in the Southern Song Dynasty, representing the essence of the West Lake's scenery. They are as follows: Autumn Moon over the Calm Lake, Residual Snow on the Broken Bridge, Dawn on the Su Causeway, Breeze-Rustled Lotus in Quyuan Garden, Viewing Fish at Flower Pool, Evening Glow over Leifeng Pagoda, Evening Bell at Nanping Hill, Three Pools Mirroring the Moon, Twin Peaks Piercing the Clouds and Orioles Singing in the Willows. See how many of them you can visit!

Seeing West Lake on foot

☉ Lingering Snow on the Broken Bridge → Bai Causeway → Zhejiang Provincial Museum/China Seal Engraving Museum → Autumn Moon Over the Calm Lake → Spring Dawn on the Su Causeway → Viewing Fish at Flower Pool .

Highlights: This is the most suitable hiking route to see West Lake, it offers a panoramic view of most of the sights listed in the "Ten Views".





Seeing West Lake on foot

Lingering Snow on the Broken Bridge / Duanqiao Canxue

☉ The meeting spot of Lady White and Xu Xian, the protagonists of the enduring Chinese folk tale *The Legend of the White Snake*, it is also a nice choice to enjoy the snow scenery of the Lake.

📍 200M east of the intersection of Beishan St and a trail to Baochu Pagoda

Zhejiang Provincial Museum (Gushan)

☉ A national first-class museum, it nestles in a traditional Chinese garden surrounded by Gushan. It's characterized by special exhibitions on Leifeng Pagoda relics, Wenlan Pavilion Library, and lacquer art, etc. A ceramic exhibition that should not be missed showcases findings of the ancient ceramic pieces that are more representative of Zhejiang styles.

Solitary Hill/Gushan

☉ Located in a quiet corner of the West Lake, the small hill is dotted with old terraces, pavilions and other famous cultural sites. Among them, Xiling Seal Society, in particular, known as "the first academic society in the world", carries a profound cultural heritage of Chinese sealing arts. 📍 Gushan Rd

Spring Dawn on the Su Causeway / Sudi Chunxiao

☉ Su Causeway was built by the famous poet Su Dongpo when he was the governor of Hangzhou in the Northern Song Dynasty. There, in spring, the green sprouting willows and pink peach blossoms present a particular enchanting sight along the undulating six stone arch bridges. 📍 Su Causeway

Viewing Fish at Flower Pool / Huagang Guanyu

☉ A famous spot for watching gold fish which symbolizes good luck in local culture, it is also one of the few places in Hangzhou to admire peony flowers.

Seeing West Lake by boat

Island tour

☉ Departing piers: No. One Park, No. Two Park, No. Five Park, Children's Palace, Zhongshan Park, Hangzhou Hotel, Flower Harbour, and Qianwang Temple.

Highlights: A cruise on a gaily-painted boat to the Small Yingzhou Island for the iconic water garden.

Song Dynasty Cultural Tour

☉ Departing pier: No.2 Park

☉ Cruise Route: No.2 Park → Leifeng Pagoda → Three Pools Mirroring the Moon → Su Causeway → Broken Bridge.

Highlights: Experience the Song Dynasty culture in a replica ancient pleasure boat, entertained by performances like Song-style tea whisking ceremonies.

Three Pools Mirroring the Moon / Santan Yinyue 🇺🇸🇬🇧

☉ The three stone pagodas are one of the symbols of the West Lake. You are recommended to take a small boat at night to see the the moonlight filters through the holes in the pagodas, creating a magical interplay of light and shadow.

Travel tips

West Lake tour boats come in different varieties such as gaily painted ancient boats replica, leisure boats, rowboats, and sculling boats. For detailed information on cruise fares and routes, please check with the boat service at each pier. The night cruise usually opens from early April to mid-November each year. Since it is highly weather-dependent, in case of special weather conditions, there may be temporary adjustments or cancellations. Please pay attention to the announcements of the boat company.





Seeing West Lake on a battery car

☉ Leifeng Pagoda at Sunset (Leifeng Pagoda Scenic Area)/Evening Bell Ringing on Nanping Hill (Jingci Temple) → Orioles Singing in the Willows → Zhejiang Art Museum → West Lake Museum → Historical buildings in Beishan Street → Breeze-Rustled Lotus in Winding Courtyard.

Highlights: This is the most relaxed way to tour the lake. Flag down a sightseeing battery car is convenient, and the ride comes with the explanations of the attractions along the way.

¥ Regular car 40 yuan/person for an around-the-lake trip; 10 yuan/ person for a section ride; an around-the-lake ride on a fancier ancient model replica costs 80 yuan/person, with a section fare of 20 yuan/person.

Travel tips

The entire journey covers about 13.5 kilometers, in about 70 minutes. It also divided into four sections(Children's Palace - Yongjinmen, Yongjinmen - Leifeng Pagoda, Leifeng Pagoda-Yue Fei Temple, Yue Fei Temple -Children's Palace), and each charges 10 (or 20) yuan/person. You can get on and off the car at any point on the round-the-lake tour. Once you leave the car, your ticket becomes invalid and you need to pay again if you want to continue the ride in a different car.

Evening Glow over Leifeng Pagoda (Leifeng Pagoda Scenic Spot)

☉ This is the site where Lady Bai Suzhen, the legendary White Snake Spirit was imprisoned. With a history of over a thousand years, the pagoda offers a panoramic view of the lake and surrounding verdant hills. The scene is particularly enchanting at sunset. 📍 15 Nanshan Rd 📞 +86 571 87982111

Central Exhibition of West Lake Museum

● The first lake museum in China, it presents an overview of the West Lake, including its dredging and renovation in the past dynasties, the origin and inheritance of its famed sights, its cultural sites, as well as related literature and historical materials and relics.

Beishan Street Historical Buildings

● Known as the "Museum of Architecture of the Republic of China Era", Beishan Street boasts a host of historical buildings from the 1920s and 1930s. They are the records of the prosperity of the city and stories of many of its famous citizens, as well as the cultural epitome and witness of modern Hangzhou.

Seeing West Lake on bike

☉ Beishan Street (Broken Bridge, Baoshi Hill) → Yanggong Causeway (Breeze-Rustled Lotus in Qu Yuan Garden, Maojiabu, Viewing Fish at Flower Pool) → Nanshan Road (Prince Bay Park, Leifeng Pagoda).

Highlights: A classic loop, allowing exercise amid charming scenery.



Baoshi Hill

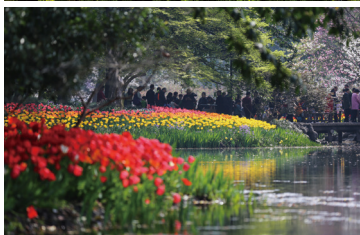
☉ The red rocks shine brightly in the sun, hence the name Baoshi (Gemstone) Hill. There are many strange rocks on the hill, making hiking an extraordinary experience. The iconic Baochu Pagoda towers majestically on the hilltop, where you are rewarded with a breathtaking panorama of the West Lake.

Maojiabu

☉ An off-the-beaten track but enchanting scenic spot in the west of the West Lake, it features a blending of pristine nature and the artistic conception of an ancient Jiangnan water town.

Prince Bay (Taiziwan) Park

☉ A romantic parkland by the West Lake, it is dotted with flowing streams and undulating grass slopes. Spring is the most beautiful time of the year when cherry and tulips bloom in profusion.

Beijing-Hangzhou Grand Canal



● A key contributor to Hangzhou's prosperity since ancient times, the Grand Canal has bred and nourished the area's Wuyue culture and Jiangnan culture. While learning to appreciate the slow life of the locals, you should not forget to make a stop at the famous handicraft museum cluster to experience the traditional intangible cultural heritage skills that have been kept alive to this date.

Travel tips

To see the Canal, you can take the water bus from Wulinmen Pier to Gongchenqiao Pier, get off the boat and visit the such sights as the handicrafts museum group, Gongchen Bridge, Qiaoxi Historic Block, Xiaoheshijie Block, Xiaohu Park and others. Or you may take a canal cruise to Tangqi ancient town, to learn about traditions and cultures of an old Jiangnan town.

Comprising an arts and crafts art gallery and three themed museums, the museum cluster showcases the old hand-making of knives, scissors, swords, fans, umbrellas, and the traditional handicrafts and arts and crafts culture of the Hangzhou area. There, you can not only admire the craftsmanship of knives, scissors, umbrellas and fans, but also learn about their long history. There are digital screens to allow visitors to immerse themselves in the beauty of craftsmanship and on-site craftsmen-teachers to offer professional guidance to those who want to experience the joy of hands-on experience in making handicrafts.

Gongchen Bridge

Built in 1631 AD, Gongchen Bridge is the longest and highest stone arch bridge among the existing ancient bridges in Hangzhou, and also the mark of the southern end of the Beijing-Hangzhou Grand Canal.

Dadou Road Historical Block

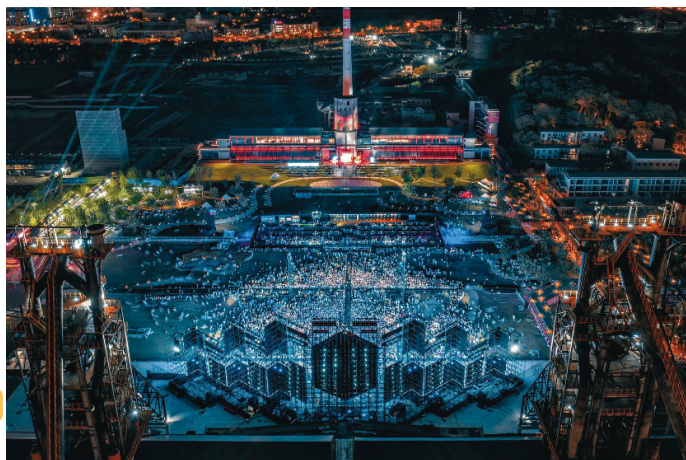

Grand Canal Hangzhou Steel Mill Park

Designed by a team of architects including Liu Jiakun, a 2025 Pritzker Architecture Prize winner, it integrates garden culture into the industrial relics of a steel giant. Visitors can camp on the lawn, attend music festivals, stroll on the abandoned railway tracks, and enjoy coffee in the former blast furnace, all amid a unique cyberpunk atmosphere.

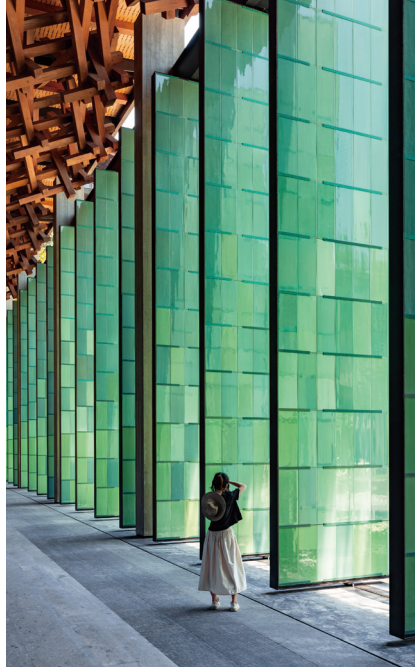

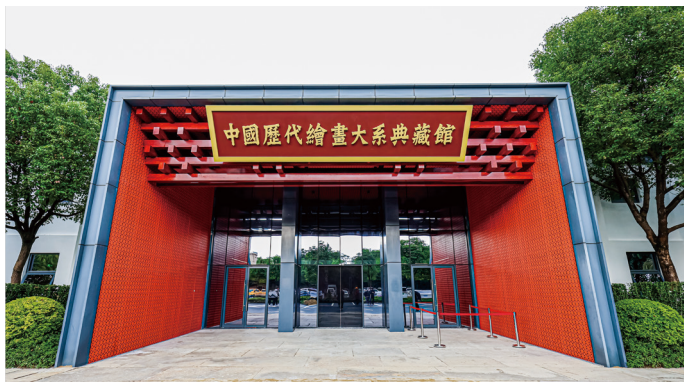

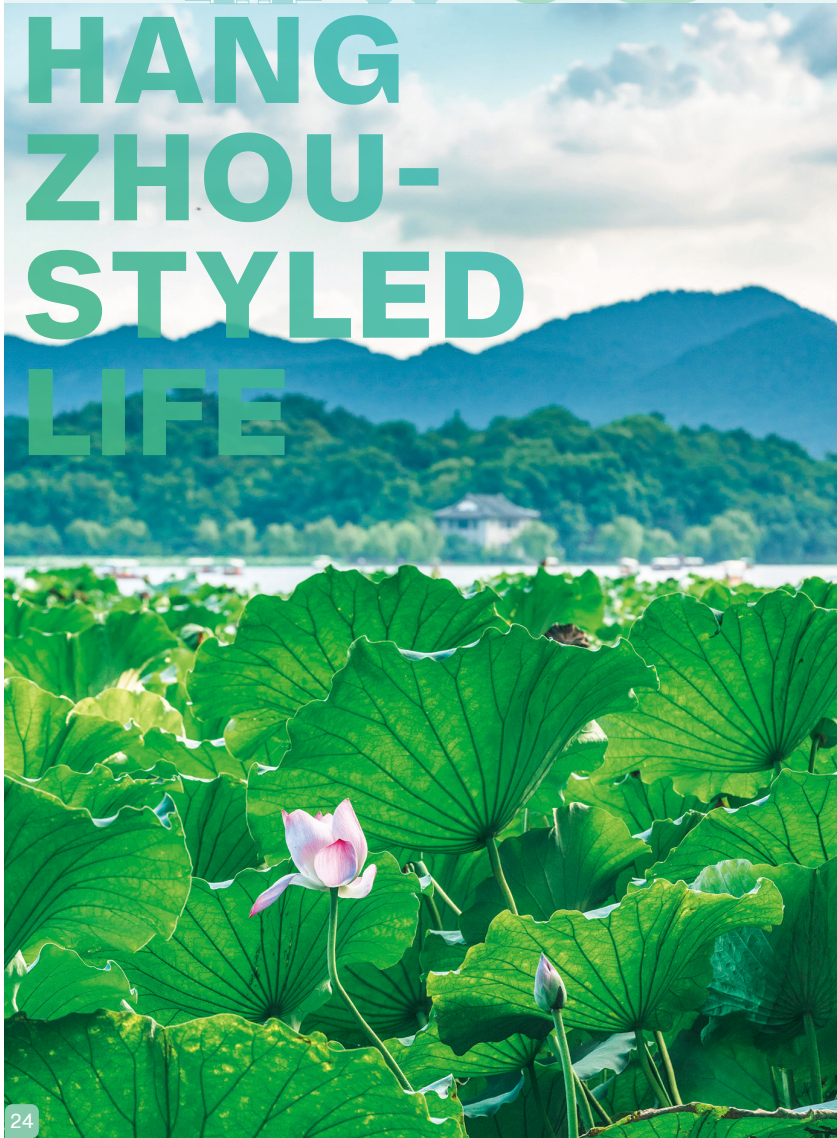

- The Overseas Visitors Payment Service Center can assist you with ATM cash withdrawals, foreign currency exchange, and guide you to domestic mobile payment products such as Alipay and WeChat.
- At the airport's intelligent terminal for real-time tax refunds, a self-help terminal combined with Alipay mode is providing quick and convenient service. After registering on the relevant Alipay page and scanning the Alipay collection code, the tax refund will be credited to your account in real-time.

Luggage Storage/Shipping Service

- In addition to the free luggage storage (to be collected before 10 p.m. on the same day) service at Hangzhou Metro's Xiaoshan International Airport Station, more than 30 other Metro stations also provide luggage storage service which is free for the first half an hour and start charging afterwards. Collection must be made before 22:30 on the same day.

Eligible individuals from 54 countries, including Russia, Brazil, the United Kingdom, the United States, and Canada, can transit through China to a third country (region) and enter China visa-free through any of the 60 open ports in 24 provinces (regions, municipalities). They are allowed to stay and conduct activities within the designated areas for up to 240 hours.

For the distance between 3~10 km, the passenger is charged 2.5 yuan/km; For the part exceeding 10 km, a 50% return allowance will be charged (3.75 yuan/km); If the taxi stops temporarily due to traffic or at the passenger's request, every 4 minute will be charged as 1.5km (i.e. a wait of 4 minutes will be charged 3.75 yuan).

Public bicycles

● You can search for "Ding-ta Travel" on Alipay or use Alipay to scan the vehicle QR code to enter the mini-APP, register and activate the deposit-free bike rental service, which is free for the first hour, and after that, the costs will be one yuan per hour. For a single rental, the daily cap is 5 yuan. When returning the bike, you need not scan the code again. Simply push the bike into the physical dock to allow it to lock automatically, or manually lock it within the electronic dock area.
